WELCOME -- The Hood River County Forestry Department manages 34,146 acres of land in Hood River County primarily for commercial timber production. These tree farm lands are open to the public and are also managed for recreation. Three systems of recreation trails exist in separate areas on property managed by the forestry. Department. They are the Northwest, Middle Mountain and East Area. Within the Northwest Area there are 89 miles of shaded, use forest roads and 92 miles of multi-use recreational trails. These routes traverse through some of the most scenic vistas in the Pacific Northwest. The trails range in difficulty from easiest to expert and change in elevation from 1,500 to 5,500 feet.

OHV Staging Areas are located at Post Flats, Bins Hill and Kingsley Reservoir. Post Flats and Bins Hill offer minimal day use facilities whereas Kingsley Reservoir provides day use and overnight camping opportunities. Additional overnight camping is available at Tucker Park and Colbridge Park. For more information check the official Hood River County webpage: www.co.hood.or.us

Some of the trails in the Northwest Area run from Hood River County property onto lands owned by others. The County is working with various agencies and private landowners so permission can be granted to allow public use of a few of these routes. In the meantime, make sure you have landowner permission before using trails.

Ride responsibly and enjoy your visit to the Northwest Area tree farm.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS --

STAGING AREA LOCATIONS

Post Flats Staging Area: (motorized)

1) From I-84 eastbound take Exit 62, turn right onto Oak Street. Travel approximately 300 feet and make a right turn onto Mt. Adams Street. Mt. Adams Street turns into County Club Road. Drive for ~1.5 miles. Turn right onto Post Canyon Road (once it becomes gravel the road is steep and rough with pot holes) and travel ~2.7 miles to the staging area. The staging area is on either side of the road. 2) From I-84 westbound take Exit 62 and turn left onto Oak Street. Follow the remainder of the directions above. This staging area offers semi-improved parking facilities and is located on Hood River County Forestry Department property. The parking area is big enough to accommodate equestrian trailers.

Bins Hill Staging Area: (motorized)

1) From I-84 eastbound take Exit 62, turn right onto Oak Street. Travel approximately 300 feet and make a right turn onto Mt. Adams Street. Mt. Adams Street turns into County Club Road. Drive for ~6.1 miles. Drive through the intersection and make a right turn onto Bins Hill Road and drive for ~2.5 miles until the road turns into gravel. Travel for ~0.5 miles to the staging area. 2) From I-84 westbound take Exit 62 and turn left onto Oak Street. Follow the remainder of the directions above. This staging area has six trailers on the right hand side of the road, offers improved parking facilities, and is located on Hood River County Forestry Department property. The area is big enough to accommodate equestrian trailers.

Kingsley Reservoir Staging Area: (motorized)

1) From I-84 eastbound take Exit 62, turn right onto Oak Street. Travel approximately 300 feet and make a right turn onto Mt. Adams Street. Mt. Adams Street turns into County Club Road. Drive for ~1.5 miles. Turn right onto Post Canyon Road and travel ~0.5 miles. The staging area begins where the pavement turns to gravel. Park on the right (north) side of the road. The area is narrow and adds a challenge to maneuvering a vehicle and trailer. 2) From I-84 westbound take Exit 62 and turn left onto Oak Street. Follow the remainder of the directions above. This staging area offers limited, unimproved parking and is located along the side of the road within the Hood River County right-of-way and is surrounded by private property. Permission has not been granted for public use of trails so ride up the road for ~1.2 miles to the trailhead at Seven Streams Staging Area.

Seven Streams Staging Area: (non-motorized)

1) From I-84 eastbound take Exit 62, turn right onto Oak Street. Travel approximately 300 feet and make a right turn onto Mt. Adams Street. Mt. Adams Street turns into County Club Road. Drive for ~1.8 miles. Turn right onto Post Canyon Road (once it becomes gravel the road is rough and has pot holes) and travel ~1.2 miles to the staging area. Limited parking is available on both sides of the road. The area is narrow and adds a challenge to maneuvering a vehicle and trailer. The trailhead is on the left (south) side of the road by the hook. 2) From I-84 westbound take Exit 62 and turn left onto Oak Street. Follow the remainder of the directions above. This staging area is located on Oregon Parks and Recreation Department property.

Family Man Staging Area: (non-motorized)

1) From I-84 eastbound take Exit 62, turn right onto Oak Street. Travel approximately 300 feet and make a right turn onto Mt. Adams Street. Mt. Adams Street turns into County Club Road. Drive for ~2.5 miles. Turn right onto Borden Hill Road and at ~1.7 miles the pavement turns to gravel. The gravel road is rough and has pot holes. Turn right and go ~0.4 miles and the first parking area is on the right back to the trees. Travel ~0.25 miles more a couple of vehicle pull-outs on the left side of the road. 2) From I-84 westbound take Exit 62 and turn left onto Oak Street. Follow the remainder of the directions above. This staging area offers limited, unimproved parking and is located on Hood River County Forestry Department property.

From I-84 to East Area Staging Location

Pinemont Staging Area: (motorized)

1) From I-84 eastbound take Exit 64, turn right onto White Salmon Highway (Hood River Bridge Road). Make an immediate turn onto US-30/OR-35. Continue to follow OR-35 for ~10.4 miles. Make a left turn onto Pinemont Road (N-17) and drive for ~2.5 miles. Pinemont Staging Area is on the right hand side of the road. 2) From I-84 westbound take Exit 64 and turn left onto White Salmon Highway (Hood River Bridge Road). Travel for ~300 feet and make a right turn onto US-30/OR-35. Follow the remainder of the directions above.


