

HOOD RIVER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING PROTOCOLS

The Board of Commissioners are trying to limit exposure to the Coronavirus for the citizens in the community and when possible conduct meetings via Webex.

In certain instances, such as a quasi judicial hearing or discussion on a quasi judicial matter it is necessary for the meeting to be held in a hybrid fashion (virtually/in-person). Most times when a hybrid meeting is held the Commissioners will appear virtually on Webex and limited staff will attend in person at the County Business Administration Building (601 State Street, Hood River OR) to facilitate the entrance of the public to the meeting to provide oral testimony/comment as needed.

Public Testimony/Comment - Written

Written comments are highly encouraged and will be accepted on any starred item on the Agenda and for Public Comments **until noon, or later as specified on the agenda and/or County website, on the day of the meeting.** Written comments should be e-mailed to Heidi DeHart at: heidi.dehart@co.hood-river.or.us. Please note that written comments received after noon the day of any given meeting may not be provided to the Board of Commissioners until after the meeting. **This does not apply to quasi-judicial hearings - written comments will be taken up to the time of and at the hearing.**

Public Testimony/Comment - Oral

During public comment periods, attendees who desire to provide oral testimony or comment on an item identified on the agenda, as accepting testimony or comment, must appear in person at the meeting location identified on the agenda and/or other notice given.
